“As the Vote Counter, I will collect and count the votes and member and guest feedback for each speaker (*hold up a ballot as an example*). When asked to cast your votes, you will find at the bottom of the ballot the Best Speaker, Best Table Topics Speaker, and Best Evaluator. Please note you do not need to list a second or most improved. An extra vote, only 1 per person per meeting, will be given to those speakers who use the word of the week. I will not cast a vote unless there is a tie, in which I will cast a vote to break the tie. I will NOT announce a tie vote. I will pass this container (*hold up a container as an example*) around to collect the votes (*explain how the container will be passed around the room for a smoother voting process*). Additionally, I will pass around an envelope (*hold up an envelope as an example*) after each speaker with their name on it to collect your feedback for them. At the end of the meeting, I will present the winners' certificates for the night to the Toastmaster of the day and give the envelopes with feedback to each speaker.”
